## WHITE WINE

<b>Kenwood, Cuvee Brut, California</b>	<b>split</b> <b>8</b>	
<b>Pinot Grigio, Gran Sasso, Italy</b>	<b>glass</b> <b>8</b>	<b>bottle</b> <b>35</b>
Aromas and flavors of ripe apple, pear, pineapple, and spring flowers. The wine is well balanced with a pleasantly fresh finish.		
<b>Pinot Gris, Seven Hills, Washington</b>	<b>8.50</b>	<b>37</b>
Bright and lively, with juicy nectarine and subtle spice flavors. Lingers gently on the dry finish.		
<b>Sauvignon Blanc, Babich, New Zealand</b>	<b>9</b>	<b>40</b>
Fresh citrus flavors along with hints of peach and melon. This is mouth-filling and smooth with no sharp edges.		
<b>Chardonnay, Kendall-Jackson, California</b>	<b>8</b>	<b>35</b>
Honeysuckle and pear aromas are balanced on the finish by tart green apples. A clean, correct California Chardonnay with a hint of sweetness, reliable as ever.		
<b>Chardonnay, The Path, California</b>	<b>8</b>	<b>35</b>
Creamy, bright and lovely with aromas of pear, apple and citrus fan out of the glass with a splash of toasty oak. The fruit really shines, succulent pineapple and melon persist on the long and refreshing nish.		
<b>Moscato, Piquitos, Spain</b>	<b>8</b>	<b>35</b>
Made in Valencia, which is better known for oranges, this wine has a delicate minerality which accompanies a slight citrus zest flavor.		
<b>Riesling, High Def, Germany</b>	<b>8</b>	<b>35</b>
Tropical fruit flavors with a slightly sweet finish balanced by crisp acidity.		

## RED WINE

<b>Pinot Noir, Indomita, Chile</b>	<b>glass</b> <b>8</b>	<b>bottle</b> <b>35</b>
Lush strawberry jam on the well-defined but, simple nose. A versatile red wine for matching with both fish and meat.		
<b>Merlot, The Path, California</b>	<b>8</b>	<b>35</b>
The nose opens with aromas of boysenberry, rose petals, vanilla and a hint of cedar. This medium bodied wine exhibits a classic Merlot profile, with crisp cranberry and tart cherry flavors, wood spice and a touch of herbs.		
<b>Cabernet, Woop Woop, Australia</b>	<b>9</b>	<b>40</b>
This Cabernet is a smooth, rich wine generously loaded with mulberries, black cherries, and spice.		
<b>Cabernet, Joel Gott,, California</b>	<b>9</b>	<b>40</b>
This Cabernet has aromatics of roasted blue fruit and sweet blackberry lending to velvety tannins.		
<b>Cabernet, Gunsight Rock, California</b>	<b>10</b>	<b>43</b>
This Cabernet has notes of sandalwood, cherry, and plum.		
<b>Zinfandel, Deux Amis, California</b>	<b>9</b>	<b>40</b>
A powerful blend of aromas in the beginning that lead into flavors of blackberry, dark plum, and black pepper that have creamy viscosity balanced by a light, playful acidity.		
<b>Malbec, Bodini, Argentina</b>	<b>8</b>	<b>35</b>
Full, fleshy, and jammy in the mouth with loads of ripe red and black fruits.
